

TECBOR[®] JOINT PASTE



DESCRIPTION

The **Tecbor**[®] **Joint Paste** is a powder plaster made of calcium carbonate, resin and various additives. It has been specially formulated for **Tecbor**[®] panel joint treatment.

APPLICATION AND USAGE

Techor® Joint Paste can be used in conjunction with the joint tape. The mix ratio is 11 litres of water for each 25 kg sack.

Before treating the joints, all the gaps caused by flaking, chipping or merely by a faulty panel joint must be filled.

It can be applied by hand, using a taping knife and a trowel. It must be given a layer, be let to dry, apply the joint tape and then cover completely.

Temperature during application and drying must be between 5°C and 30°C. Do not apply to dirty or damp surfaces or surfaces at temperatures of less than 5°C. Avoid application in strong winds.

Do not apply on substrates that are frozen or defrosting, nor on hot surfaces or in direct sunlight.

Do not add water or powder to the paste if it begins to set.

For upright salient angles, use reinforced tape.

HYGIENE AND SAFETY

• Hygiene:

Tecbor® Joint Paste is not harmful in itself but it does contain some elements that are.

- Industrial hygiene: ensure it is handled in a ventilated area to reduce dust and vapour concentration.

- Ingestion: it is not considered to be particularly hazardous if ingested under normal conditions of use.

If the product is accidentally spilled on the floor, sweep and remove the product spilled from the relevant containers. Dilute the remainder and thin

Clean work tools with abundant water.
